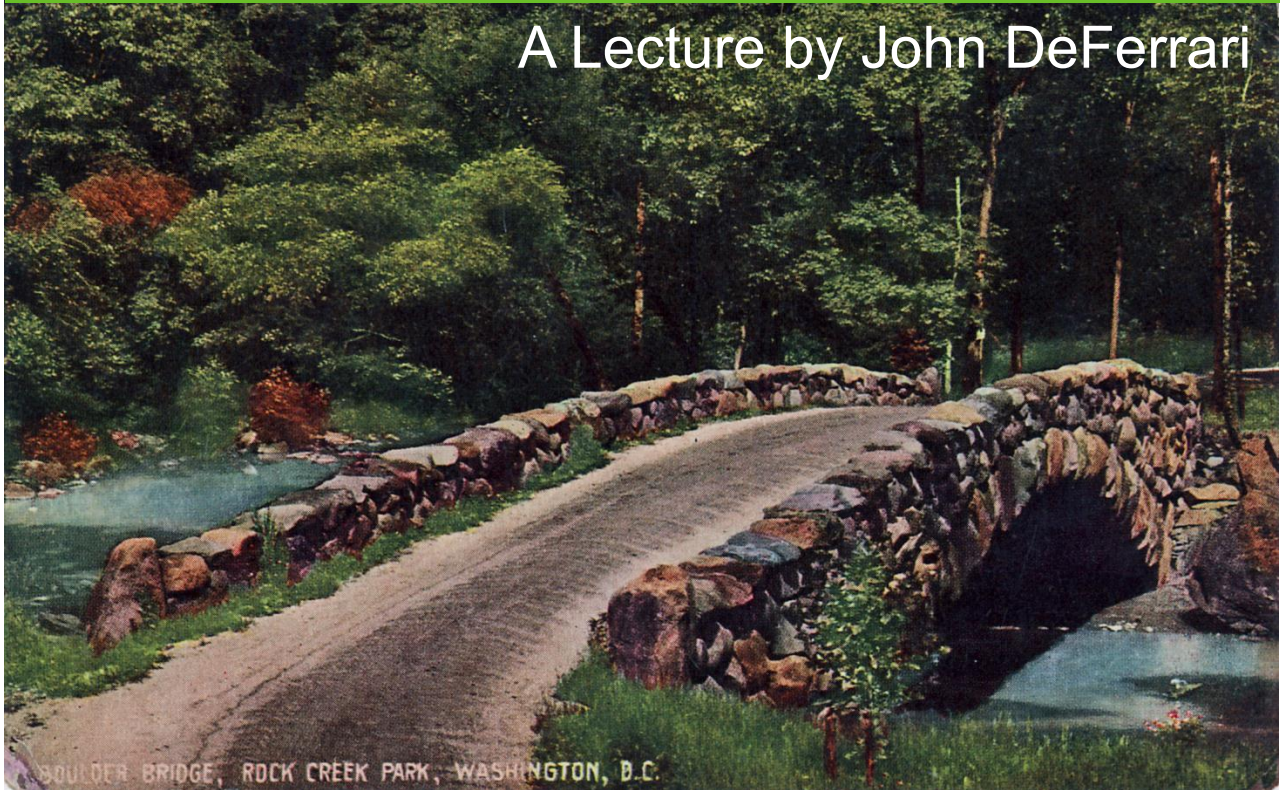


# HISTORIC BRIDGES OF ROCK CREEK PARK
