Online Registration Opens for New Fiscal Year

Ready to create your interagency agreement (IAA) with FEDLINK? [Online registration](#) is open for Fiscal Year 2019. The system will prompt you for your FEDLINK ID and password, the same password you use for FEDLINK's ALIX-FS account management system. Be sure to enter your FEDLINK ID in lowercase letters

Within 72 hours, FEDLINK will email you a registration approval and post your IAA (or IAA alternative) online for review. Just return to the FEDLINK Online Registration Web site and click on Get my IAA! and review it on screen. If correct, begin your agency's authorization process immediately by printing out the IAA and securing the appropriate signatures from your agency. (If registration is not approved, we will email you the reason within 72 hours.)
