FEDLINK Offers More Electronic Resource Options

FEDLINK has added eight new options to its list of electronic resources vendors for Fiscal Year 2019. Members may access these and other electronic resource contracts through FEDLINK's Transfer Pay and Direct Pay options. To request contract information, point your browser to <https://www.surveymonkey.com/r/FEDLINKdirect> or send an email to fedlinkIR@loc.gov.

With Transfer Pay, via a signed Interagency Agreement, FEDLINK issues delivery orders to vendors and handles related accounting services on behalf of the customer. With Direct Express, member agencies can cite the FEDLINK contract number on their agency purchase order and send it directly to the vendor.

Request Direct Express Contract Information

Direct Express contract information is online for electronic resource, bibliographic utility, or foreign language courseware vendors. By citing the FEDLINK contract number on a purchase order, members can send orders directly to the vendor. Customers must execute all contract actions in accordance with the FAR or other applicable regulations and **send FEDLINK a copy of any executed orders**. Upcoming End-of-Year Deadlines

Don't forget to provide full funding and complete requirements to FEDLINK by the deadlines. Upcoming deadlines for orders include:

- **July 15**
 - Preservation/Digitization
 - Library Support Services (>\$250K)
- **August 1**
 - Electronic Resources (>\$250K);
 - Serials with October & November start dates (<\$250K); and Serials with December start date (>\$250K)
- **August 15**
 - Preservation/Digitization
 - Library Support Services (<\$250K)

Planning budgets for Fiscal Year 2021? FEDLINK Transfer Pay fees will increase from 6.75 percent to 7.50 percent. Direct Express fees will remain the same at the current level of .75 percent. This is FEDLINK's first baseline fee increase since 2010.
